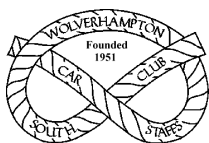
Start at The Hollybush - Bring Maps 127 and 138, Romer, £1 coin, pencils, torch etc.

WSSCC Winter Series 2011 - 2012 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1 Jurisdiction

The event will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Limited (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and any Supplementary Regulations or additional written instructions that may be issued.

2 Format

Route or locations to visit will be defined at the start of the event. Points will be awarded for correctly recording each codeboard and accurately plotting its location.

All codeboards will be visible from the car, but it may be necessary to get out of the car to read them.

3 Eligibility of Entrants and Vehicles

The event is open only to members of WSSCC. The driver, co-driver and up to two passengers may comprise the crew, all of whom must sign the entry form, produce a valid club membership card at

the start, and must complete the signing on formalities and declarations. Club membership forms will be available at the start for those wishing to join WSSCC at that time.

Only unmodified standard road vehicles and road rally vehicles which comply with all relevant Road Traffic Legislation are eligible. Auxiliary lights are allowed only if standard equipment. Up to four competitors may compete in one car, any one of whom may be nominated as the driver. All potential drivers must sign the driver's declaration on the Entry Form.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to any vehicle at their discretion.

4 Start and Finish

9.45pm	Finish Control opens
10.00pm	Finish Control closes
10.30pm	Results announced

Any competitor not handing in their answer sheet at the Finish by 10pm will be deemed to have retired.

6 Tie-Decider

In the case of a tie between two crews the winner will be the crew issued with the route the latest.

7 Final Instructions

Final Instructions which will carry the same force as these Supplementary Regulations may be issued at signing on.

8 Road Traffic Act Insurance

All drivers are deemed to have arranged their own cover for the duration of the event.

9 Number of Entries

Only twelve entries will be accepted.
Places can be reserved in advance by contacting the organisers by email.

10 Classes

There are no separate classes in this event. All competitors will be considered as one class.

11 Awards

There will be no prizes on this event in order to minimise costs.

12 Entries

Entries will be accepted at the start subject to eligibility and availability of places.

16 Protests

Entrants may not, at risk of disqualification, use any means of telephonic or electronic communication or positioning apparatus except in an emergency.

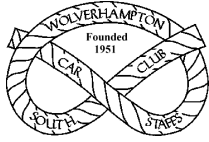
